**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SUNNYSIDE,
WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER
TO SUBMIT THE YVCOG SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK
GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE 1ST STREET AND YAKIMA
VALLEY HIGHWAY INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, The Yakima Valley Conference of Governments (YVCOG) has a call for funding for transportation projects through the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG).

WHEREAS, The City of Sunnyside has identified a problematic intersection through multiple six-year TIP updates and a City Safety Plan.

WHEREAS, The Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) from YVCOG requires no match if constructed by 2027.

WHEREAS, pursuing the funding award is consistent with the City's 6-Year Capital Improvement Program and City Safety Plan.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to submit the application, execute all documents associated with the application, is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON,** as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Sunnyside hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit the funding application to the Yakima Valley Conference of Governments (YVCOG) and execute all documents, and act on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
