
WHEREAS, the City Council aims to reflect on the values and principles upon which our nation was founded; including liberty, justice, and equality for all.

PASSED this 1st day of July 2024.





WHEREAS, *fireworks displays and other community events are held to celebrate this event in Sunnyside to celebrate our shared history and values, and to come together as one nation.*


