WHEREAS, we come together to recognize the contributions and achievements of individuals with disabilities; and


WHEREAS, the City Council aims foster inclusivity, promote equality, and break down barriers faced by individuals with disabilities.

WHEREAS, there is still work to be done to break down the barriers faced, we encourage individuals, organizations, and communities take action to create inclusive environments for all; and


NOW THEREFORE, I, Dean Broersma, as Mayor of Sunnyside, Washington do hereby proclaim July 26, 2024 as
