

RESOLUTION 2024 - 89

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE, EXECUTE AND ADMINISTER PROBATION SERVICES INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS

WHEREAS, The Sunnyside Municipal Court and Yakima County District Court Probation Department seek to continue an Interlocal Agreement to continue providing Probation Services as required by law or based on the specific needs of the court.

WHEREAS, The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth the terms and conditions upon which the parties agree to continue Probation Services and to enumerate other related provisions that contribute to their mutual benefit.

WHEREAS, This Agreement is established pursuant to RCW 39.34.180(6). Additionally, ARLJ 11 provides that the "... Method of providing these services (referring to probation supervision) shall be established by the presiding judge for the local court to meet the specific needs of the court." Each court shall continue to have exclusive original jurisdiction of all criminal law violations committed within the jurisdiction of that court as authorized by statute or ordinance.

WHEREAS, the County acknowledges that the City contracts to provide court services for the City of Toppenish; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement shall encompass all cases referred to the County for supervision services by the City and any municipalities with which the City has contracted.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that approval of such agreement is necessary to assist the court in the management of criminal justice and thereby aid in the preservation of public order and safety.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the “Yakima County District Court Probation Services Interlocal Agreement-City of Sunnyside” a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved: and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute and administer this agreement for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures heron in accordance with law.
