

RESOLUTION 2024 - 94

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE,
WASHINGTON, OBLIGATING ALL REMAINING STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL
RECOVERY FUNDS (SLFRF) AUTHORIZED BY THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN
ACT (ARPA)**

WHEREAS, the City received funds from the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds/American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) that were committed to programs including the following: Community Improvement, Health & Safety, Safe Community, staffing for the Future, Utility Billing Assistance, and COVID Response to help mitigate the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on City of Sunnyside (Attachment A); and

WHEREAS, the City Council met on December 16, 2024 to review the program expenditures and make adjustments to the remaining available funds; and the City Council has determined the funding provided under ARPA provides a unique opportunity to cover temporary operating shortfalls until economic conditions and operations normalize; and

WHEREAS, the City Council elects to obligate the remaining \$2,427,600 of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds for general government administration, staff, and administrative facilities and is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to cover the costs for general government administration, staffing, and the purchase of goods and services for city facilities, due to the temporary revenue shortfalls, with State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds received through the American Rescue Plan Act.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
