

RESOLUTION 2025 - 25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A PUBLIC WORKS BOARD APPLICATION FOR WASTEWATER DIGESTER EMERGENCY REPAIRS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION AND FUNDING PROCESS AND COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside's wastewater treatment plant requires critical repairs to the methane gas piping and burner system to maintain compliance and prevent environmental hazards; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of these repairs ranges from \$150,000 to \$250,000, exceeding the available funds in the City's sewer budget; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Public Works Board has emergency funding available, and this project qualifies for a 50% grant and 50% loan at 2% interest for a 20-year term; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to seek external funding to ensure the timely and cost-effective completion of these necessary emergency repairs.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON:

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit an application to the Public Works Board for funding assistance for the wastewater digester repairs along with any costs associated with the application process.

SECTION 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute all

necessary documents related to the application and funding process.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is authorized to make the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, Resolution numbering, section/subsection numbering and any references thereto.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures heron in accordance with law.


