**WHEREAS**, law enforcement officers, including the members of the Sunnyside Police Department, play an essential role in safeguarding the rights, safety, and well-being of our community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside wishes to honor and recognize their roles in our local government and their accomplishments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby approves a proclamation, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" proclaiming May 11-17, 2025 as National Police week in the City of Sunnyside.

**SECTION 2.** The City of Sunnyside encourages citizens to support our local law enforcement.

**SECTION 3.** This resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.


