A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION 2025 - 42 TO CHANGE THE EFFECTIVE DATE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF FIRE DEPARTMENT STANDBY OF PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF FIREWORKS IN THE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES TO JANUARY 1, 2026

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 2025 - 42 on June 9, 2025 updating and approving a Schedule of Fees and Charges for the Fire Department standby for public displays of fireworks in accordance with SMC 5.42.020(c); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it appropriate to delay the implementation of said fees to allow additional time for notice to various organizations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to amend the original resolution to reflect a new effective date of January 1, 2026;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON:

SECTION 1. The effective date established by Resolution 2025 - 42 for the implementation of the updates Schedule of Fees and Charges for Fire Department standby of public displays of fireworks is hereby amended. The revised effective date shall be January 1, 2026.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is authorized to make the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, Resolution numbering, section/subsection numbering and any references thereto.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
