

RESOLUTION 2025 - 56

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO AUTHORIZE SUBMISSION OF A FUNDING APPLICATION
TO THE PUBLIC WORKS BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Commerce has an open call for agencies to submit funding applications for capital projects to the Public Works Board (PWB) Traditional Financing Program,

WHEREAS, eligible work under the PWB Traditional Financing Program includes construction of municipal utility infrastructure such as lift stations and wastewater treatment plant upgrades;

WHEREAS, the City has identified in its approved General Sewer Plan and Wastewater Facilities Plan Amendment the need for construction of a new headworks at its wastewater treatment plant and construction of a new Exit 67 lift station;

WHEREAS, the headworks process has failed at the wastewater treatment plant and the Exit 67 lift station requires repairs and an increase in capacity to accommodate economic growth;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to authorize submission of a funding application, is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Sunnyside hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit a funding application to the PWB

Traditional Funding Program for the construction of improvements on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is authorized to make the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, Resolution numbering, section/subsection numbering and any references thereto.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures heron in accordance with law.
