

**RESOLUTION 2025 - 58**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SUNNYSIDE,  
WASHINGTON, DECLARING CERTAIN COMMISSARY ITEMS  
SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THEIR DONATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the city of Sunnyside has transitioned to a new jail commissary;

**WHEREAS**, most items were sold to the new commissary provider, with the exception of certain thermal tops and bottoms valued at \$428.25;

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department recommends donating these items to Camp Hope, a local organization that provides a majority of our homeless services in the community;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY  
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON:**

**SECTION 1.** The thermal tops and bottoms, as listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, are hereby declared surplus property.


**SECTION 2.** The surplus thermal tops and bottoms will be donated to Camp Hope.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute and administer all documents and contracts necessary to dispose of the thermal tops and bottoms (list attached) in accordance with applicable procedures and law.

**SECTION 4.** The City Clerk is authorized to make the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, Resolution numbering, section/subsection numbering and any references thereto.

**SECTION 5. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
