

**RESOLUTION 2025 - 100**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SUNNYSIDE,  
WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO  
SIGN TASK ORDER NO 2024-02 DEVELOPMENT OF CLIMATE  
ELEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside would like to request that Council authorize the Interim City Manager to sign Task Order NO.2024-02 for HLA to develop a COMMERCE-approved Development of Climate Element Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Washington State Department of Commerce is allocating \$150,000.00 to the City of Sunnyside to finance the development of the recently required Climate Element in the City of Sunnyside's upcoming Growth Management Act (GMA) Comprehensive Plan update, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside's Commerce Grant timeline was July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2025, and

**WHEREAS**, due to various timing considerations, such as the final COMMERCE contract and the initial HLA task order, all deliverables were not able to be completed by June 30, 2025, and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the agreement is for the City of Sunnyside to move forward with the Development of the Climate Element Agreement, and

**WHEREAS**, with the remaining funding and deliverables transitioning to a new grant with a July 1, 2025, through December 31, 2026, timeline, and

**WHEREAS**, the total funding amount is being reduced to all additional funds for future implementation, and

**WHEREAS**, the original grant (July 1, 2023-June 30,2025) is reduced to \$25,900.00 and the new grant (July 1, 2025- December 31, 2025) is \$56,100.00, for a total of \$82,000.00.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON:**


**SECTION 1.** The Washington State Department of Commerce (COMMERCE) is allocating \$150,000.00 to the City of Sunnyside to finance the development of the recently required Climate Element in the City's upcoming Growth Management Act (GMA) Comprehensive Plan update.

**SECTION 2.** The City desires to contract with HLA to develop a Commerce - approved Climate Element (PLAN).


