

RESOLUTION 2025 - 95

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SUNNYSIDE,
WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO
ENTER INTO A THREE-YEAR MICROSOFT ENTERPRISE
AGREEMENT WITH CDW GOVERNMENT, LLC FOR MICROSOFT
365 GOVERNMENT COMMUNITY CLOUD (GCC) LICENSING
RELATED SOFTWARE ASSURANCE**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside utilizes Microsoft products to support essential government operations, including secure email productivity applications, data storage, device management, cybersecurity, and internal communication needs; and

WHEREAS, the City's current Microsoft Enterprise Agreement expires on December 31, 2025 and renewal is necessary to ensure uninterrupted access to critical technology systems; and

WHEREAS, CDW Government, LLC and authorized Microsoft licensing partner has provided a quote dated November 20, 2025 for a 3-year renewal under the Microsoft Enterprise 6.6 Agreement, procured through the OMNIA cooperative purchasing contract; and

WHEREAS, cooperative purchasing through OMNIA Partners satisfies competitive procurement requirements and provides cost effective access to enterprise level licensing.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that renewing the Microsoft Enterprise Agreement is necessary and in the best interest of the City to ensure continuity of services, maintain cybersecurity protections, and support efficient municipal operations;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON:**

SECTION 1. Authorizes the City Manager to execute a 3-year Microsoft Enterprise Agreement with CDW, government LLC in an amount not to exceed \$189,818.58 plus applicable taxes, and to make three annual payments during the term of the agreement.

SECTION 2. Authorizes an additional one-time fee of \$15,000 plus applicable taxes to be paid to Robinson Tech for implementation services associated with the migration of mailboxes to Exchange online.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk is authorized to make the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, Resolution numbering, section/subsection numbering and any references thereto.


SECTION 5. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures heron in accordance with law.
