

RESOLUTION 2026 - 05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING FUNDING FROM THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTEMNT OF HEALTH DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Health administers the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program to provide funding for potable water system improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized the submittal of an application to the Washington State Department of Health Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program for funding assistance for potable water system improvements on November 12, 2024 (RES 2024-81); and

WHEREAS, the proposed project includes design and construction improvements to Wells 6 and 7, which are experiencing iron bacteria and sanding operational issues that require capital improvements to return them to useful service; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Health has approved the City's application and awarded funding to the City of Sunnyside through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that accepting the awarded funding and authorizing execution of all agreements and documents is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside;


**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby accepts the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund award from the Washington State Department of Health and authorizes the Interim City Manager to execute all agreements, documents necessary to accept, administer, and implement and implement the awarded Drinking Water State Revolving Fund funding on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is authorized to make the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, Resolution numbering, section/subsection numbering and any references thereto.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures heron in accordance with law.
