

**RESOLUTION 2026 - 07**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING  
THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A FUNDING APPLICATION TO THE  
SUPPORTING INVESTMENT IN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM  
FOR THE 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND LINCOLN AVENUE LIFTSTATION**

**WHEREAS**, Yakima County, through the Supporting Investment in Economic Development (“SIED”) program, supports public infrastructure that retains and creates job growth within the County; and

**WHEREAS**, to support and sustain economic growth, capacity improvements are needed to the 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Lincoln Avenue Lift Station in the City of Sunnyside (“City”), which would otherwise fail or limit economic growth and the potential of job creation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City sought funding through the Department of Ecology to complete engineering design for the 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Lincoln Avenue lift station, but additional funding is needed to for construction and construction administration services; and

**WHEREAS**, the SIED program requires a 20% match requirement and of the remaining total project costs, 50% is grant and 50% is loan;

**WHEREAS**, the estimated total project cost is \$1,424,300 resulting in a match requirement of approximately \$284,860, and after using existing funding from Ecology, the remaining match requirement is approximately \$78,860; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to submit a funding application to the Yakima County SIED Board for grant

and loan funds, is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Council of the City of Sunnyside hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit a funding application to the Yakima County SIED Board, for construction and construction administration of improvements on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
