**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING  
THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A FUNDING APPLICATION TO  
THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Safe Routes to School Program (“SRFP”) through the Washington State Department of Transportation has an open call for applications; and

**WHEREAS**, eligible projects or work for funding under the SRFP include transportation improvements that would improve the ability for students to safely reach school, which improvements must be within a 2 mile radius of a school; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has been diligent in pursuing funding programs in order to make improvements to accessibility within the City consistent with the City’s ADA Self-Evaluation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, several ADA ramps within a two mile radius of schools require replacement to meet ADA requirements and would be eligible for SRFP funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to submit a funding application through SRFP is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Council of the City of Sunnyside hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit a funding application for the improvements, attached hereto as Exhibits “A”, and act on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.




PROJECT VICINITY MAP


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


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




