

How to Report a Crime

- Identify yourself - name, address, and telephone number (even if you are using 911).
- Tell the dispatcher the type of crime you are reporting.
- Let us know if the crime is "in progress" or "has already occurred".
- Where is (did) the crime taking place? Be as specific as possible.
- Give descriptions of the suspect(s):
 - How many are there?
 - Are there any guns, knives, sticks, etc.?
 - What direction did they go?
 - Are they in a car or on foot?
 - Is anyone chasing the suspect(s)?
- Describe the vehicle:
 - Is it a car - pickup - van?
 - What color is it?
 - What is the license number and state issued?
 - Are there any dents in the body?
 - Is there anything else that makes it unique?
 - What direction did it go?
- Stay on the line until you are told to hang up.
- After calling the police, call a neighbor so they can help watch for the suspect and assist you in giving a complete description.
